

Year 10 examinations are scheduled for Week 3 - 4, Term 2 (May 18 to 25 May 2018)

Formal examinations provide students with the opportunity to demonstrate the depth of understanding of work covered over an extended period of time. It also provides students with first hand experience of formal examination procedures. The examination results, in conjunction with other assessment results and staff knowledge of student engagement and understandings will form the basis for Senior School Course Selections in Week 7 & 8 Term 2.

English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities and Social Sciences (MESH) exams will be conducted in the Performing Arts Centre/E Block on Thursday 24th and Friday 25th May. Please see below for examination schedule. Normal timetable continues where an exam is not scheduled. Examinations in other courses will be conducted during scheduled class time with teachers informing students of the scheduled examination period.
