Student Parking Policy

Driving a motor vehicle carries with it serious legal and social responsibilities, especially within our school environment where staff, students, families and community members access the school and library parking areas.

It is a privilege, not a right, for Year 12 students to access parking bays at Lesmurdie Senior High School. **Please also be aware that space in the student car park is EXTREMELY LIMITED and as such, parking permits will be allocated on a needs basis.** Your understanding of this is appreciated.

In order to apply for and obtain a Lesmurdie Senior High School Student Parking Permit, students need to accept and abide by the following conditions:

- Apply for and receive a parking permit BEFORE driving a vehicle on the school premises
- Display your parking permit at all times on the car dashboard
- Arrive at school a minimum of **15** minutes **before** the first school bell (to avoid congestion)
- Leave the school car park a minimum of **15** minutes **after** the bell at the end of the day
- Park in your designated bay **ONLY**
- Enter and leave the school car park and vicinity with care and responsibility
- Carry **ONLY** the **authorised siblings** as outlined on your permission form
- Requests to leave the school grounds must be through the normal procedures for signing out and written parent permission is required
- The car park is **OUT OF BOUNDS** from 8.40am until 2.55pm each day including recess and lunchtime, unless a student leave pass is shown
- Students who park in the school parking area without a permit will not be eligible to park their car for a period of one school term
- **STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE PERSONAL VEHICLES TO DRIVE TO SCHOOL EXCURSIONS OR OFF-CAMPUS SCHOOL EVENTS**

*If breaches of any of the above conditions are reported, the matter will be referred to the Senior School Coordinator. Serious ongoing breaches will be referred to the Deputy Principal - Senior School and may result in the Parking Permit being withdrawn, parents being notified and the parking bay may be allocated to another student. This information will be forwarded to the Senior School Manager to record against that student's Good Standing. **Please note: serious breaches may lead to suspension as well as the above consequences.***
