This qualification will enable you to gain practical skills and knowledge in:

- Working and communicating in a team environment
- Using and maintaining mechanical tools and equipment
- Application of correct lubricants and/or fluids handling techniques



This VET qualification aims to provide you with basic employment skills required to work in the automotive area. It is primarily designed as a stepping-stone for higher level training.

N.B. A certificate will not be issued by the RTO until they receive all student evidence and it meets the required standard to be deemed competent.

Duration: Delivered over two years under the proposed auspices of AIET as an integral part of the senior school course; Automotive Engineering and Technology.

Cost: \$120 per annum enrolment fee which includes consumables, issue of Statement of Attainment and Certificate on completion.

Pathway: Apprenticeship in light / heavy duty automotive.
