Year 7 Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS) Selection - 2026

IMSS provides instrumental music services to more than 450 public primary and secondary schools, reaching more than 15,000 students from Years 3 to 12. In addition to weekly small group instrumental lessons, students have opportunities to participate in enrichment music activities which combine students working collaboratively across year levels and with students from other schools. At LSHS, in The Arts, students study a semester each of Visual Arts and Performing Arts. Students who choose IMSS will study music as their Performing Arts subject for one semester, however, will continue with their IMSS music lesson for the whole year.

Please be aware there is a \$25.00 compulsory charge for Year 7 IMSS which will be included in your Charges and Contributions. If a loan instrument is required from the Department of Education there is a hire fee of \$110 per instrument per year (non-refundable).
